



M.G.L. Chapter 115 is a state benefit for eligible veterans and eligible dependents of deceased veterans. This benefit is designed to help Massachusetts Veterans and their families within certain income and asset limits. Note that even if your income is higher than the specified amounts you still may qualify for reimbursements of medical expenses. Please contact Estelle to discuss eligibility: 508-285-0274

For 1 in household \$2,510 max monthly income, \$8,400 asset limits (single)
For 2 in household \$3,407 max monthly income, \$16,600 asset limits (married)


